

Design Committee Meeting Summary

5 March 2019

Present: Wayne Allgaier, Diane Ellis, Sue Blair, Mabelle Lee, Jean Doyle, Karin Birch

Status of projects to be accomplished in 2019 (and *responsible committee member*):

- **Triangular sign in Square Corner Park** (*Sue Blair*). Sue and Sophie have replaced outdated information. Sue will clean Plexiglas with special cleaner and determine if it needs to be replaced. Map of downtown needs key to numbered businesses. Cost: \$0 (unless plexiglass needs to be replaced).
- **Pocket Park rehabilitation** (*Karin Birch*). \$900 grant has been received. Three color options will be presented to the public for choice to paint the bench. Mabelle will obtain the paint. Karin will need 4-5 volunteers on April 13 to paint the bench and do landscaping. Cost: to be covered by grant.
- **The Brunswick Citizen lot landscaping** (*Sue Blair*). Sue enlisted the services of Fred Derr (landscape architect) and 3 members of Building Veterans to rebuild the flower bed. Fred and Sue will return (on April 13?) to complete the landscaping. Cost: \$0.
- **County Main Street Art Project** (*Diane Ellis*). Susie Leong, the art consultant, was in Brunswick to consider possible sites for the art work. Cost: to be paid for from County Main Street funds.
- **Sidewalk flower planters** (*Mabelle Lee*). Mabelle will contact Louisa (from Thanksgiving Farms) re: purchase of spring plantings. Sue will contact her friend Louise who has expressed an interest in watering the flowers during the summer; Sue will take her on a tour of the planters to see if this is feasible.
- **Window display upgrades** (*Jean Doyle*). Started formulating work plan for this project at today's meeting. Jean will develop this further and bring back to committee.
- **YMCA Park rehabilitation**: will be moved to 2020.]
